Education initiatives for Flood-affected communities in Sindh & Balochistan

- Plantation Drives across 36 Star schools in Balochistan and Sindh
- Village Education Committee (VEC) Meetings to discuss challenges related to girls' education and explore ways to facilitate improved access and quality
- Video case studies were recorded to document various educational initiatives and activities.
- Schools across four districts were visited to evaluate the performance and attendance of both teachers and students, ensuring accountability and promoting a higher standard of educational delivery.



Action for Gender Equity & socio-economic uplift of Displaced afghan women and girls



- PAGE distributed **577** notebooks, and stationery sets to targeted students to support and accelerate their learning process
- Effectively implemented Package C classes in **15** targeted schools to enhance educational opportunities in designated areas
- In Rawalpindi, Peshawar, and Quetta, PAGE conducted digital marketing classes for **140** beneficiaries (**60 from Quetta, 60 from Peshawar, and 40 from Rawalpindi**), focusing on building online platform presence and creating pages and groups across various platforms.
- Beneficiaries' participation in an exhibition organized by The Balochistan Women Business Forum in Quetta, where **10** beneficiaries set up four stalls to showcase their products.
- **8** Beneficiaries from Rawalpindi and Quetta boot camps showcased their products at fashion shows and exhibitions in **August 2024**, where they demonstrated entrepreneurial skills, built connections with designers, and sold directly to customers.

Out of school children (OOSC) education project in Karachi

- On **August 14th**, students celebrated Pakistan's Independence Day with traditional songs, dances, and art displays, fostering unity and national pride.
- On **September 6th**, students participated in Defence Day activities, including presentations and discussions, instilling patriotism and appreciation for the armed forces.
- On **September 13th**, Miss Nadeya Bukhari and Mr. Kassim visited Schools in Korangi, Karachi, and conducted an interactive session on hygiene, emphasizing the importance of handwashing and cleanliness.
- Teachers encourage creative expression through fun activities like drawing and painting, making the learning environment more enjoyable for students.



Enrolment, Retention and Progression (ERP) of Out of School Children (OOSC) in ICT

- Celebrated the achievements of **10** exceptional girls from **PAGE Star Schools** who graduated as part of the first batch of the Middle Tech Initiative.
- Under the Summer Festa Program, organized in collaboration with the Ministry of Federal Education and Professional Training, **21** dedicated volunteers delivered **24** interactive sessions to **881** government school students, extending the impact to over **2,000** beneficiaries.
- Held a certificate distribution ceremony and hosted a concluding hi-tea to appreciate the contributions of our volunteers.
- In partnership with NUST Professional Development Centre (PDC) and The Asia Foundation, PAGE hosted an inspiring session on "Exploring Physical & Digital Reading Opportunities for Young Leaders." This program was designed for students enrolled in our Star Schools, expanding their access to reading and learning resources.



Star schools in Tharparkar

- On **August 14th**, students celebrated Pakistan's Independence Day with traditional songs, dances, and art displays, fostering unity and national pride.
- Students participated in a reading activity that improved their literacy skills enhanced comprehension, and fostered a love for reading and critical thinking.



Empowering Afghan Refugee Girls' Education in Pakistan

- Conducted a "Child Inclusion" training session for educators, providing teachers with a full-day workshop focused on inclusive teaching practices.
- Organized an online session in collaboration with Finance Global on "Finance for Students: Money, Saving, and Budgeting". The session delivered valuable insights into financial management, highlighting the importance of budgeting and saving for students.
- Hosted a Dental Camp in collaboration with Colgate, promoting oral hygiene through an informative session on proper brushing techniques. The camp included free dental check-ups and distribution of care kits, encouraging healthier smiles for students.



Education Project in Swat

- 3-day child safeguarding training in **August 2024** for seven teachers from Khushal School and College, focusing on child protection and creating safe school environments.
- One day trip for scholarship holders' girls, including a plantation activity to raise awareness about environmental sustainability and promote tree planting.
- **STEM** event at Khushal School and College where students showcased science and technology projects, attracting external visitors and media attention.



Achieve- Empowering Girls with Skills that shape the future

- We signed an agreement for **Achieve-II** and we're now expanding our reach to engage **200** young girls across Rawalpindi, Islamabad, Peshawar, and Larki Marwat with the financial support of ZINDIGI & technical assistance of The Kings' Trust International.
- Conducted the Achieve Advisors' Training for **10** female teachers from Punjab, ICT & KPK.
