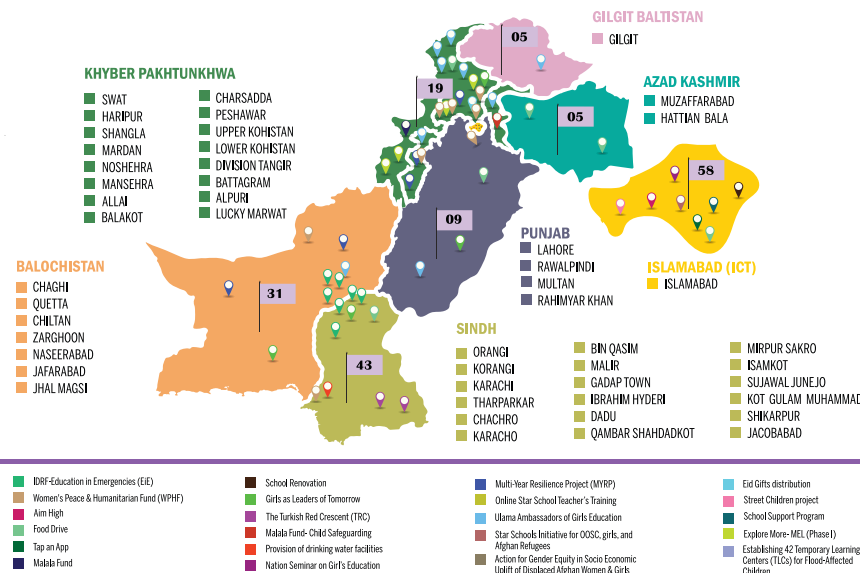

Let's continue our journey together, championing education, empowerment, and brighter tomorrows for all.

Happy New Year 2024!

We Established New Star Schools!

- 36 new Star Schools opened for out-of-school children, with 1306 students enrolled (66% girls)
- 15 Star Schools opened for Afghan Refugee Children
- 43 Temporary Learning Centers (TLCs) opened for children in flood-hit areas of Sindh and Balochistan.
- Employment opportunities created for 37 new teachers from local marginalized communities
- 31 Teachers trained in ALP Teaching Methodologies
- 155 Students in four Star Schools are provided with nutritious meals.
- 80 of 96 Students passed Category 'C' exams conducted in FDE Star Schools in Islamabad.
- Water boring facility installed in five Star Schools to overcome missing water facilities.
- Plantation drive launched in three Star Schools in Islamabad to spread awareness among 215 students regarding Climate Change.
- Dental Medical Camp arranged for Afghan Community (children & mothers)



We Empowered our Partners

- Participants from partner organizations across Pakistan trained under Multi Years Resilience Programme (MYRP) program.
- 80 beneficiaries trained on Social Inclusion and Gender (SIG) & Child safeguarding
- 130 beneficiaries trained on School Health & Nutrition Program (SHNP)
- 150 beneficiaries trained on Mental Health & Psychosocial Support (MHPSS)



We Helped Afghan Refugees!

- In Collaboration with WPHF, capacity Building Trainings arranged for 15 teachers
- 567 Afghan Students enrolled in 9 Star Schools
- 170 beneficiaries receiving training on Digital Marketing
- 150 Afghan Women received Vocational Training
- 210 Afghan Women and children completed 1st and 2nd rounds of Language and Cultural Class
- 458 Afghan Students passed Package A assessments



We Empowered Young Girls!

- A collaborative initiative by PAGE and Prince's Trust International with Zindigi Trust support.
- Pilot launched to work with 100 female students across three schools in Islamabad and Swat
- 10 advisors trained for program implementation.
- Curated Curriculum introduced to provide sessions on confidence, communication, entrepreneurship, employability, and digital skills.
- 16 Sessions tailored to prioritize safety, engagement, and empowerment through exposure visits.



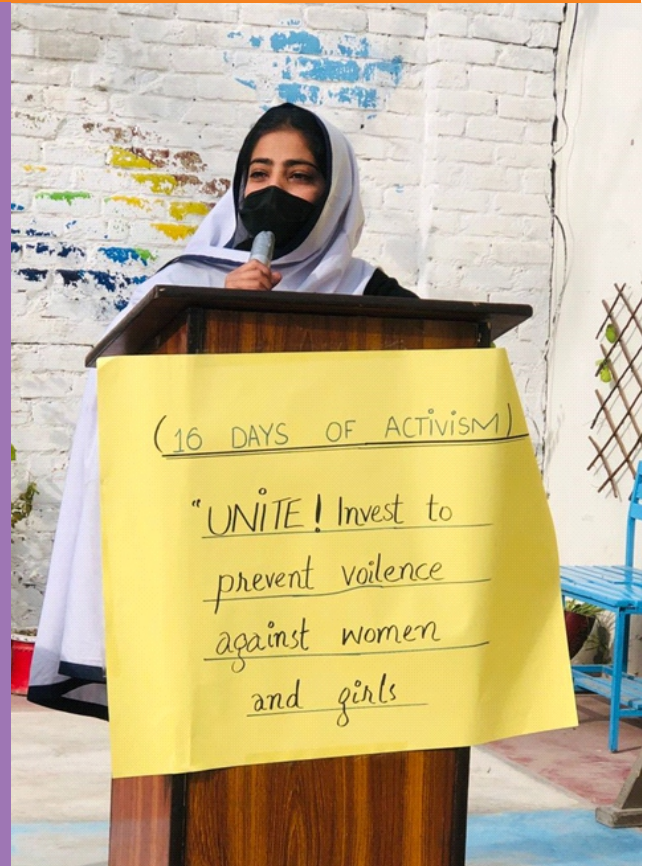
We Helped Flood-Affected Children in Distress

- In Collaboration with the International Development And Relief Foundation (IDRF), PAGE established 42 Temporary Schools in three flood-affected areas in Balochistan including Naseerbabd, Jaffarabad, and Jhal Magsi; and four in Sindh including Shikarpur, Jacobabad, Qamber Shahdad Kot, Dadu.
- 1283 children (boys and girls) enrolled to pursue free and quality education.
- The project concluded on Sep 30 2023, Next Phase is to begin in January, 2024.



We Supported Girls Education in Swat

- In partnership with Malala Fund, PAGE provided Scholarships to 30 girls students in Khushal School Swat
- Provision of Uniforms, School Bags, Tuition Fee, Stipend, transportation expenses, school examination fees, purchase of school supplies
- 34 Teachers trained on Safeguarding and Provision of Quality Education
- Formation and capacity building of students' hygiene, health, sports, and law society clubs for the personal, academic, cognitive and physical development of 330 students
- Impact created on 5000 Community Members in five villages

Through its convincing and impactful work, PAGE has successfully acquired the extension for its ongoing projects with MALALA FUND in Swat. PAGE has also entered into the second phase of its Multi-Years Resilience Programme (MYRP) after approval from Education Cannot Wait (ECW).

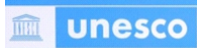
We Strengthened Parenting Practices in Flood-Affected Communities!

- In collaboration with GPI, PAGE Established 42 learning centers in flood-affected regions Starting in December 2022.
- PAGE promoted parenting support through educational sites about Parenting for Lifelong Health (PLH).
- Engaged 1,928 parents (1,178 men, 750 women) through educational sessions
- Covered districts in Sindh (Qamber Shahdad Kot, Shikarpur, Jacobabad, Jamshoro) and Balochistan (Naseerabad, Jaffarabad, Jhal Magsi)
