Pakistan Peoples Party Education Manifesto 2024



Analysis: Priority is given to addressing the issue of OOSC. 2 new programmes are to be launched to promote girls' education and skill development. 5% of GDP to be given to education.

- Address the crisis of 22 million out-of-school children
- Rooted in the principles of equality, inclusivity, gender parity and accessibility
- 5 percent of GDP (USD 17 billion) to education
- Free and mandatory education
- inclusion of girl-children will be prioritized
- Launch of programmes like "Beti Parhao, Kismat Jagao" & "School Jao, Hunar Barhao"
- provision of essential resources for schools
- Establish a primary school within a 30-minute radius & a secondary/higher secondary school within a 60-minute radius
- Implement e-learning platforms
- Promote an inclusive curriculum that respects cultural & social diversity, gender Parity
- Lady healthcare workers for advocacy on girls' education

Pakistan Muslim League Noon Education Manifesto 2024



Analysis: More focused on expansion of projects launched during PMLN rule. Mention an increase in budget allocation but no figure is given. Mentions Priority to be given to girls' education and make them 'Agents of Change'.

- Launch 'Wheels of Opportunity' Program - Safe and Accessible Transport for every student
- Nationwide Evening Schools - Focus especially on girls and children from disadvantaged sections of society
- Expand Zewar-e-Taleem Programme, Punjab Education Endowment Fund and Pakistan Education Endowment Fund (PEEF) to include marginalized communities, Daanish School System, 'Schools for the Brick Kiln Workers', Launch the National Innovation Award to encourage high-quality research.
- Scholarship for deserving
- Establish 'The National Commission on Excellence in Education'
- Establish ECE Centers, Vocational Centers, Special Education Centers, Teacher training

Jamat-e-Islami Education Manifesto 2024



Analysis: Focus on targeted policies for girls' education, compulsory religious education, and eradication of co-education. 5% of GDP to be given to education.

- Interest-free loans for students
- Increment In salaries of private and government teachers.
- Allocation of 5% of GDP for education
- Increment in the budget of HEC, scientific and technological research.
- Separate institute for female students to eradicate co-education and targeted policies to address girls' education issues
- 50 new colleges and technical universities
- Compulsory religious education
- Free education till matric
- Educational emergency to address the crisis of 22 million Out of School Children
- Basic and compulsory education on Entrepreneurship
- Promote an inclusive curriculum that respects cultural & social diversity, gender Parity.

Pakistan Tehreek-e-Insaf Education Manifesto 2024



Analysis: Priority is given to updating the existing structure by improving access, quality, and provision of facilities. 4% of GDP to be allocated to education.

- Elevating Teachers as Beacons of Knowledge
- Strengthening Educational Institutions at Local Level
- Increased education spending in the first 5 years to 4% of GDP
- A revolution in teaching methodologies, curriculum, and assessments will ensure that every child receives a high-quality education.
- Primary education and technical skills, scholarship programs, a comprehensive policy on education of schools and madrassas
- Empower women alongside their male counterparts by the creation of educational opportunities.
- Implementation of standardized curricula, seamless integration of the Internet and social media
- platforms, and extensive use of technology to enhance the accessibility and effectiveness of education.
- Expanded access to schooling, particularly for girls, through public-private partnerships and targeted enrollment campaigns.
